Governor's Cup

To be awarded to the highest scoring Adult Amateur Hunter or Modified Adult Amateur Hunter, based on points. In case of a tie, the Adult Amateur Hunter would be awarded the trophy.

Adjutant General's Perpetual Trophy

To be awarded to the highest scoring Children's Hunter, based on points. In case of a tie, the winners will hack off for the award.

Town of Newtown Perpetual Trophy

To be awarded to the highest scoring Short Stirrup Rider, based on points. In case of a tie, judges discretion will award the trophy.

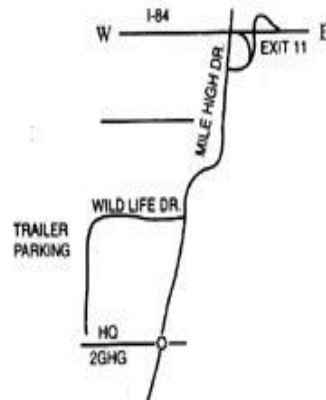
Second Company Governor's Horse Guard Horse Show Rules & Regulations

1. Every class offered herein which is a CHJA or CHSA Point Class will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current Rules of the sponsoring organization.
2. Open to all riders. It is not necessary to be a CHJA or CHSA member to compete (exception – CHJA Medal classes). In order to compete for CHJA/CHSA annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA/CHSA. A copy of the CHJA & CHSA Rule Books, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership applications are available at the show secretary's office and at www.chja.net. & www.chsaonline.com.
3. The Second Company Governor's Horse Guard, the State of Connecticut, the Horse Show Committee and all Show Officials shall not be responsible for any accident or injury that may occur to any animal, person or property, and each exhibitor, or employee of such exhibitors, shall hold them harmless and indemnify them against legal proceedings or liabilities from such accident, injury or loss of property.
4. All judges decisions are final. No one may speak to a Judge or see the Judges Cards unless first obtaining permission from the Show Steward.
5. Championship competitors must show in a qualifying class.
6. If a horse or rider is entered and does not show, fees are forfeited unless a Veterinary certificate is presented or a bona-fide casualty occurs prior to the class.
7. Management reserves the right to cancel, split or combine any class it deems necessary, to establish a starting order and enforce a two minute time limit.
8. Management reserves the right not to delay classes due to schedule conflicts with exhibitors or trainers. **No refunds.**
9. Management reserves the right to prohibit any person or horse from attending or showing in the ring, further to remove same from the show for just cause, including, but not limited to offensive abuse, physical or verbal, without being liable for compensation.
10. Proper attire is required.
11. No martingales or tie-downs in any flat or under saddle class.
12. No horses allowed in spectator/food areas.
13. **Negative Coggins test and rabies vaccinations required for all entries. Same must be shown upon entrance to the show grounds! This will be strictly enforced!**
14. An office fee of \$15 will be accessed for each entry
15. Regular Classes \$20. Championship Classes \$25. Medals \$30.
16. Entries Close July 23, 2010. Post entry fee of \$15 per entry.

Shown at the walk-trot & canter both ways of the ring. Diagonals and leads considered. Fences not to exceed 18'.

Modified Adult Equitation Division CHJA / CHSA

Open to Adult Amateur riders who have not won six blue ribbons in recognized Adult Equitation Classes including CHJA Adult Medal Classes, but excluding Modified Adult Equitation Classes. For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult if, as of Dec. 1 of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher at more than three recognized horse shows within the past two show years. Fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders in this division cannot show in any other recognized classes at the same show where the fences exceed 2'6".

At the same show, riders may not cross enter into Children's Equitation, Children's Pony Hunter, Pony Hunters, any Medal classes that exceed 2' or any class where fences exceed 2'6". No combinations permitted.

Small Ponies to jump 2', Medium Ponies 2'3", Large Ponies 2'9". Second phase is a flat phase which is mandatory and will count 50%. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases. Judges may require additional testing using current USEF Tests 1-8.

CHJA Children's Medal

Entry Fee: \$30.00

Open to junior members of CHJA who are eligible for Children's Hunter and have not shown over a course where fences have exceeded 3' at a recognized show, and have never qualified or shown in a 3' Equitation Finals including the CHJA Medal finals. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is over a course of not less than eight obstacles 2'6" in height, which must contain two changes of direction after the first fence, with no combinations. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at the walk, trot and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases. The Judges may require additional testing using current USEF Tests 1-8

CHJA Junior Medal

Entry Fee: \$30.00

Rider to be a Junior member of CHJA who has not reached his/her 18th birthday. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is to be shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles 3'0" in height. At least one combination including an Oxer is required. The course must contain at least two changes of direction (change of lead) after the first obstacle. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. The judges may require additional testing using current USEF tests 1-19

CHJA Adult Medal

Entry Fee: \$30.00

Rider to be an Adult Amateur member of CHJA. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles 3' in height, which must include one combination including an oxer and two changes of direction (change of lead) after the first fence. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at the walk, trot and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the rider in both phases. To fill the class at least four competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-19.

Marshall & Sterling Medals

To fill the class three riders must complete the course. Only one rider per horse. Rider must be a member for points to count toward qualifying for the finals. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Further specifications and the scale of points awarded available at the secretary's desk.
